Swedish actor is participating in HBO-SKY Limited's upcoming drama "The Third Day" together with star-studded cast:

Swedish actor Börje Lundberg (A Man Called Ove -Beat-multiple International Productions) has just finished the recording of "The Third Day" which began in July.



Following the successes of "Chernobyl", HBO and Sky's new joint venture now comes and it is the first original drama produced by Sky's new production house - Sky Studios.

The series, which is in 6 parts, is produced by Brad Pitt's Plan B Entertainment and UK producer Adrian Sturges together with Punchdrunk International.

It is divided into 2 parts where Sam (Jude Law) is drawn to an island on the British coast where the islanders at all costs preserve their traditions. The second part is more focus on Helen (Naomi Harris) who comes to the island for answers.

The Third Day is directed by Bafta winning director Marc Munden (Utopia, National Treasure, The Mark of Chain) and Philippa Lowthorpe (Three Girls, The Crown, Cider with Rosie):
